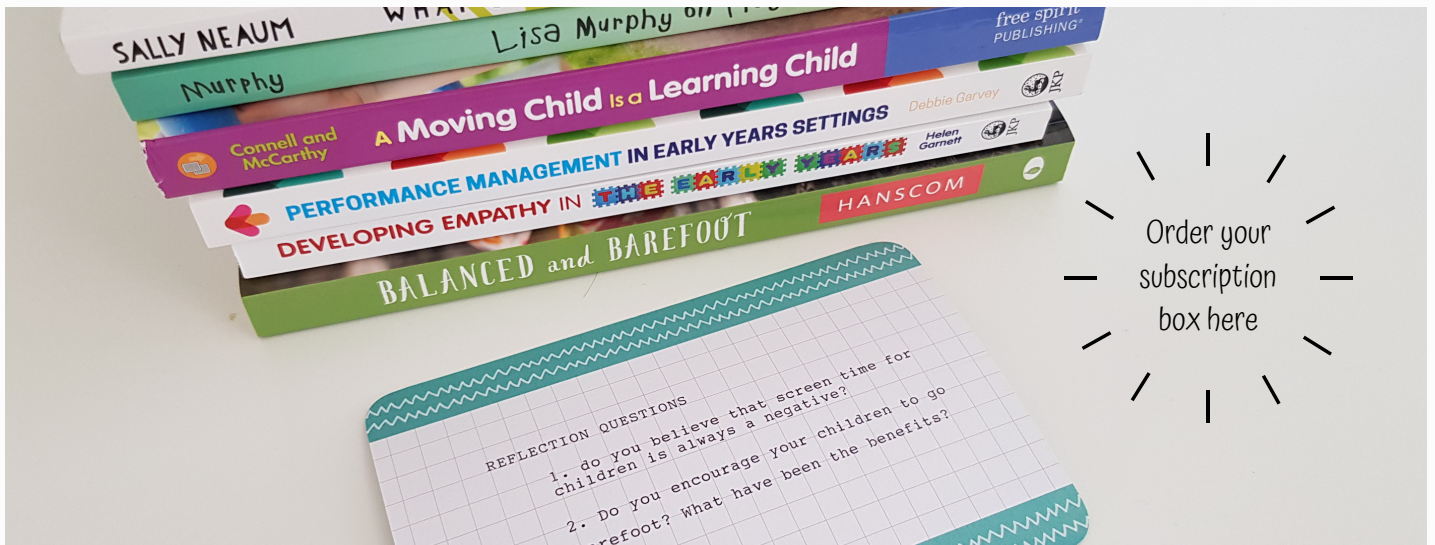

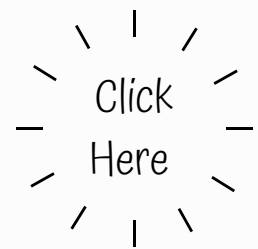

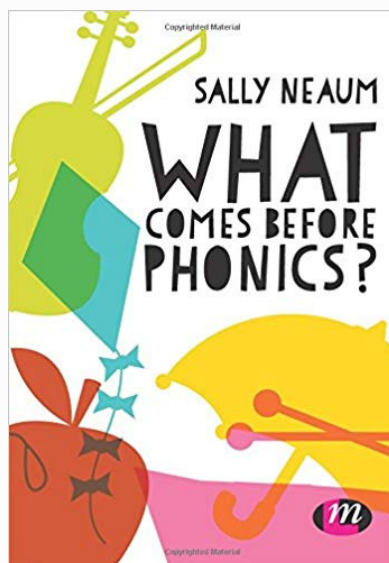


Reflection Questions
